### **Selection Criteria (based on UEG criteria):**

#### **SINGEM Member at 31.12.2018**

- Age below 40 years
- Must have as country of residence: Italy
- Must show at least one publication as first, corresponding or last author in a neurogastroenterology/gastroenterology journal (NMO, Gut, Gastroenterology, Annals of Surgery, CGH, AJG) or at least 3 publications in other renowned peer-review journals
- Must have a primary research interest in Neurogastroenterology

### **Scoring criteria:**

All nominations are reviewed and scored by members of the SINGEM Scientific Committee, based on the following criteria:

#### **Up to 7 points**

- Publication quantity & quality

#### **Up to 5 points**

- Other markers of esteem (e.g. prizes, awards, conference activity etc.)
- Evidence of independent research activity (last authorship, grant income, lab staff)

#### **Up to 3 points**

- Academic training record including PhD and post-doctoral experience
- Clinical activity (ability to perform functional testing outpatients visits, etc.)
- Academic curriculum (Medical School Degree Dissertation, Gastroenterology Speciality Dissertation, PhC Dissertation, research activity, etc.)

### **Award:**

- 1000 Euro
- Eventual talk on a proposed topic during the next SINGEM National conference

### **Selection Criteria (based on UEG criteria):**

#### **SINGEM Member at 31.12.2018**

- Age below 40 years
- Must have as country of residence: Italy
- Must show at least one publication as first, corresponding or last author in a neurogastroenterology and motility/surgical journal (NMO, Annals of Surgery, Journal of Gastrointestinal Surgery, Br J Surg, Surg Endosc) or at least 3 publications in other renowned peer-review journals
- Must have a primary research interest in Neurogastroenterology (surgery)

### **Scoring criteria:**

All nominations are reviewed and scored by members of the SINGEM Scientific Committee, based on the following criteria:

#### **Up to 7 points**

- Publication quantity & quality

#### **Up to 5 points**

- Other markers of esteem (e.g. prizes, awards, conference activity etc.)
- Evidence of independent research activity (last authorship, grant income, lab staff)

#### **Up to 3 points**

- Academic training record including PhD and post-doctoral experience
- Clinical activity (ability to perform functional testing outpatients visits, etc.)
- Academic curriculum (Medical School Degree Dissertation, Gastroenterology Speciality Dissertation, PhC Dissertation, research activity, etc.)
